Standard Specifications:

1. Monolithic Slab:

Concrete per code

2. Framing:

Floor joist: 2 x 10 joist (2nd Floor)

Floor sheathing: ¾" tongue and groove glued and nailed

Walls: 2 x 4

Ceiling: 2 x 6

Rafters: 2 x 6

Exterior sheathing: 7/16" OSB

Roof sheathing: 7/16" OSB with Radiant Barrier

Ceiling height: first-9 ft.-second 8 ft. (except where noted in plans)

3. Exterior Finish:

Front: cement siding with brick accents per plans

Rear and Sides: cement siding per plans

Foundation: monolithic concrete slab

Soffits and facial: vinyl soffits and aluminum facial

Shutters: per plan

Porch columns: square PVC 10" front 8" rear

Gutters: white

4. Sheetrock:

All interior walls ½", water resistant ½" sheetrock around showers and tubs

5. Ceiling/wall finish:

All ceilings flat throughout

6. Insulation:

Exterior walls = R-13, floor = R-19, ceiling (blown)= R-30 (to meet code requirements)

House will have house wrap

7. Doors: (exterior):

Front door: fiberglass (per plans)

Porch door: full lite door

All other doors per plan

8. Garage door: front entry

Style: white non insulated steel carriage door

Automatic garage door opener - with reversing action with two remotes

9. Door knobs:

A. Exterior/outside doors: round knob and deadbolt

B. Interior knobs/locksets: round knob

10. Windows:

White vinyl frame, low-e glass, grilles between glass, screens throughout - all windows per plan.

11. Cabinets:

Painted (white) Shaker cabinets with granite in kitchen

Painted (white) Shaker cabinets with granite in baths

Painted (white) Shaker cabinets in laundry

12. Plumbing:

All plumbing will be done in accordance to plans and will be in compliance with code. Woodhurst Delta fixtures

Master bath tub: fiberglass with tile surround

Master bath shower: fiberglass

Tub/shower combination: one piece fiberglass five foot unit in guest

Kitchen sink: white fireclay farmhouse sink

Sewer: included

Exterior faucets: two

Hot water heater: Rannai tankless water heater

13. Electrical:

Each bedroom and great room will have a ceiling fan, coaxial and CAT6 cable with a network box. Flood light will be on the rear of the home. Rear porch will have TV outlet.

All electrical will be in compliance with code.

Buyer is responsible for final hook up of telephone, cable and/or other connection source. Buyer is responsible to change all utility accounts over to buyer's name as of the closing date.

14. Flooring:

Tile: kitchen backsplash, fireplace surround, master bath, master bath tub surround, guest baths, and laundry room

LVP click flooring: great room, kitchen, ½ bath, breakfast, dining, and foyer

Carpet: all other living areas.

15. Trim specs:

Wood casings on all windows and doors

5 ¼" base

Crown molding throughout the home

1x4 panels in dining room

16. Painting:

Interior walls/room colors: washable flat latex throughout, owner's choice of 2 colors (dark colors are not included)

Interior trim color: white semi-gloss enamel

Exterior colors: 2 satin wall colors (dark colors are not included)

Exterior trim color: white satin enamel

17. HVAC: heating and A/C systems:

14 SEER rating

Gas line to water heater, HVAC unit and fireplace

18. Kitchen appliances:

Freestanding electric range (GE GRF500PVSS)

Over the range microwave (GE JVM3162RJSS) vented outside

Dishwasher (GE GDF510PSRSS)

19. Mirrors, bath accessories and closets/shelving:

Wire shelving in closets

Matching accessories in all baths, matching framed mirror in master bath

20. Roof Shingles:

Architectural shingles

21. Roof ventilation:

Continuous roof ridge vents (all roof peaks)

22. Landscaping:

Front and back yard: Bermuda sod and sprinklers

Shrubs and pine straw included

The sprinkler system will be connected to the neighborhood irrigation water system. Buyer will receive a bill from TIE investment yearly for the water.

23. Porches and Patio:

Porch floors will be concrete

24. Fireplace:

Gas vent free

25. Driveway:

Front entry driveway

26. Sidewalk:

Sidewalk to front door from driveway

27. Clearing/excavation:

Additional tree removal will be an additional cost. Additional landscape charges may apply.

28. Selections and changes after submittal:

Please be advised that while making your personal home selections that you are assured and confident with your selections. Any changes to the selections after they have been submitted will be subject to a minimum charge of \$800.00 plus the cost to make the change. Materials are ordered in advance. Many items will not be able to be changed after construction has begun.

29. Substitutions:

Welsh Custom Homes reserves the right to implement products of equal or greater value when the specified product cannot be received in a timely fashion or an unforeseen problem arises during the construction process. All left over material will be returned to the applicable supplier. Any materials that are not returnable, shall remain the property of the builder and are not to be removed from the job without written consent from the builder.

30. Miscellaneous:

\$6,000.00 Buyer incentive for using preferred lender and closing attorney
No materials from outside sources or vendors are permitted to be used during construction.

31. Builder warranty:

Builder provides all permits and material, workman's, and builders risk insurance. Home will have a one-year warranty on all workmanship (excluding cosmetic and limited landscape) from date of occupancy from builder and a 2-10-year structural warranty for years 2 – 10 provided by a third party. A walk thru with homeowner will be done prior to closing and all deficiencies will be corrected. At or around the 90-day mark after taking possession of the home, the homeowner will be responsible for emailing in a cosmetic list for any normal cosmetic concerns that need to be addressed. The house will be built in accordance to owner's specifications and plans. All work to be done in accordance to plans and will be in compliance with National, State and Local codes and in accordance to South Carolina Building Standards.

32. Construction Timeline:

Construction timeline is 8-10 months from permit issue date. The builder will notify the closing coordinator of any significant delays in construction. Construction can be delayed by unusually unfavorable weather, pandemics, strikes, natural disasters and unavailability of labor or materials. Builder will notify the closing coordinator when construction is 30-45 days from completion to allow buyer and lender to prepare for closing. Closing dates will only be given to the closing coordinator.

33. Contract termination:

Contractor may at its sole discretion, by written notice to Buyer terminate for convenience this Contract, when Contractor determines that it is in the best interest of Contractor to do so upon not less than three (3) days written notice to the buyer. The Builder shall pay any earnest money, construction deposit, and or change order money previously submitted by the Buyer.

Notwithstanding the aforementioned, the Buyer shall not be entitled to any additional reimbursements of any sort, consequential damages or damages of any sort as a result of the termination of the contract.

Portfolio Home Selections

At this point you have reviewed the House Options available for your floorplan, which is one great way to customize your home with upgrades. Now it is time to make selections on the finishes that are included with the home. All of the selection options are included with the price of the home.

You will be working through a digital book of selections for the both interior and exterior of the home. A few important things to note:

- Read all information/instructions on each page in full.
- Selections must be submitted in full. Partial selections will not be accepted.
- These selections are final selections. Please be sure you are confident in your submissions.
 - Changes are discouraged and will incur additional fees. Any changes to selections after they have been submitted will be subject to a minimum charge of \$800 plus the cost to make the change. Some items may not be able to be changed after construction has begun.
 - Changes will delay the construction timeline.
- No materials from outside sources or vendors are permitted to be used during construction. You must make selections from the options offered by the builder.
- Review the Specification sheet for the home before starting the selections. The Specification sheet provides the specifics that you will need to refer to while making the selections. For example, the Specification sheet details where LVP and carpet are throughout the home.
- We have included manufacturer names where we felt it would be helpful. We encourage you to spend time researching the options if you would like to see additional photos. This is especially helpful for the granite selections.

Color Package Selection: Select 1 color package. Nickel and bronze are included options. **Black is available as an upgrade. Only select black if you selected the upgrade for black fixtures on the House Options part of your contract.** The color package is carried throughout the home with doorknobs, hinges, light fixtures, plumbing fixtures, bath accessories, and cabinet hardware.
